### EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 28

*Series of 2020*

#### **CREATION OF THE INTER-AGENCY CONTACT TRACING TEAM FOR THE COVID-19, ESTABLISHMENT OF LIGTAS COVID-19 CENTERS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG, PANGASINAN, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS**, Article II, Section 15 of the 1987 Constitution, which declares that the Senate shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

**WHEREAS**, on March 8, 2020, President Rodrigo Duterte issued Proclamation No. 922, declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines due to the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) and the Code Alert System of COVID-19 was raised to Code Red Sub-Level Two (2) in accordance with the recommendation of the Department of Health (DOH) and the Inter-Agency Task Force for Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF), and subsequently the Presidential Proclamation No. 929, Series of 2020 was issued declaring a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to Covid-19;

**WHEREAS**, as of April 14, 2020, there have been more than five thousand (5,000) confirmed cases of the COVID-19 in the Philippines, with three hundred thirty-five (335) deaths due to COVID-19;

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 11469, or the “Bayanihan to Heal as One Act”, has placed the country in a State of National Emergency, and has declared the urgent need to: (a) mitigate, if not contain, the transmission of COVID-19; (b) undertake measures that will prevent the overburdening of the healthcare system; (c) immediately and amply provide healthcare including medical tests and treatments, to COVID-19 patients, persons under investigation (PUIs), or persons under Monitoring (PUMs); (d) ensure that there is sufficient, adequate and readily available funding to undertake the foregoing; (e) partner with the private sector and other stakeholders to deliver these measures and programs quickly and efficiently; and (h) promote and protect the collective interests of all Filipinos in these challenging times;
